#### School information



Gate Times: Reception gate opens at 8.30. Children will walk themselves up the reception garden path into class. Main school gates open at 8.20 for years 1 & 2, where staff are able to receive children from parents who need to leave. Please ensure you inform a member of staff you are leaving your child on the playground. Pupils should be in school at 8.30am to start lessons. All school gates will close at 8.40 prompt.

Pack lunches: All pupils who attend Infant schools are entitled to FREE SCHOOL MEALS. If by choice your child would prefer NOT to have a hot meal in school, we ask that parent/carers follow the guidance notes sent out earlier this term for what constitutes as a healthy lunch box. We know we have many "fussy eaters" within school and they may limit the choices you want to offer them. If this applies to your child please come and speak to me on the school gate.

Water bottles: Children are encouraged to bring water bottles to school each day. As a school we promote healthy eating/drinking. It is important that children are encouraged to drink water rather than an alternative drink which may be high in sugar and calories.





FREE FOOD FRIDAY: On this day (Fridays!!) we share with our families, food donations from the local community and businesses. This means families can stock up on a few store cupboard items which may help them out over a few days. If you would like to donate to this good cause we will leave "dump bag" by the kitchen steps next to the bagels each morning. ( Please receive fresh produce. Store cupboard items may include, sugar, salt/ pepper, cakes, biscuits, tins of potatoes, rice, pasta, cooking sauces etc.) We know how hard times are at the moment and we want our families to feel supported.
